Cooking Lesson

Every month the IVs will decide a desiring dish to cook. No need a professional chef with well-equipped kitchen, they can be cooks themselves. Fall was coming but seemed like Summer still wanted to leave some heat here for us, so nothing was better than a bowl of Bún. Grab all the ingredients, do the magic trick then BANG! Here comes a bowl of Bún Bò. Food is always an endless love.



Recipe: Bun bo (south noodle)

Sauce:

- 2 spoons of sugar

- 1 spoon of vinegar 2 spoons of fish sauce 3 spoons of water, Garlic, pepper, chilli **Boil the sauce**
- Fry the onions until they are crispy
 - Boil the rice noodles
- Mix the salad with coriander and mint at the bottom of the bowl
 - chop/crush roasted peanuts
- Cut the noodles in smaller places and put on top of the noodles.
- Roast bean sprouts and put on top of noodles
 - Fry beef or tofu in small thin pieces

Order In the bowl:

Salad, noodles, bean sprouts, meat, onion, nuts, sauce
